Description	Provides a living arrangement which integrates shelter and services for older persons who need additional supervision, but do not require continuous nursing care	Provides a living arrangement which integrates shelter and food with medical, nursing, psychosocial and rehab services for persons who require 24-hour nursing supervision.

Nursing Care	Home health agency provides intermittent/episodic services as needed. Continuous nursing not provided. Exception may be Hospice when sufficient resources are available.	Provides continuous nursing care and Hospice care
